Environmental complaints	8 June 2022 (Referred by Gammon Construction Limited on 8/6/2022)	<p>Environmental Complaint No: EC-053- K10/RE/00011091-22</p> <p>Details of Complaint</p> <p>The complaint is related to the odour from construction machines described as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Complaint of diesel smell arising from the operation of construction machines in CKR construction site near Grand Waterfront. -Please ensure the works fulfill the relevant environmental legislation and their subsidiary regulations. -Please take necessary environmental measures to minimize the environmental nuisance arising from the construction site. <p>Details of Investigation and findings:</p> <p>A. According to the information provided by the Contractor, 2 excavators, 2 generators and 2 mobile cranes were operated at Ma Tau Kok on 8 June 2022.</p> <p>B. As reported by the Contractor, routine maintenance for all machines at the site has been provided by the Contractor to make sure that those machines were well-maintenance before commencing construction works. The fuel filter in the machines will be checked frequently when it has functioned more than 500 hours or six months in accordance with general practice from the Contractor. One of used excavator was checked during the complaint received date.</p> <p>C. Besides, Euro V diesel was also used for the machinery fuel to comply with the standard in Cap. 311I Air Pollution Control (Fuel Restriction) Regulations.</p> <p>D. The regular site inspections were conducted by ET and the Contractor on 8 June 2022 and 15 June 2022. No adverse observation was against the dust and no malodour was smelled from the machines during the site inspections. In addition, proper NRMM labels were affixed on the operated machines to comply with the requirement in Cap. 311Z Air Pollution Control (Non-road Mobile Machinery) (Emission) Regulation.</p> <p>E. It is considered that machines have been maintained properly by the Contractor and no adverse observation against dust impact was recorded and no unpleasant smell was detected during the site inspections at Ma Tau Kok on 8 and 15 June 2022.</p>	Closed	1	53
